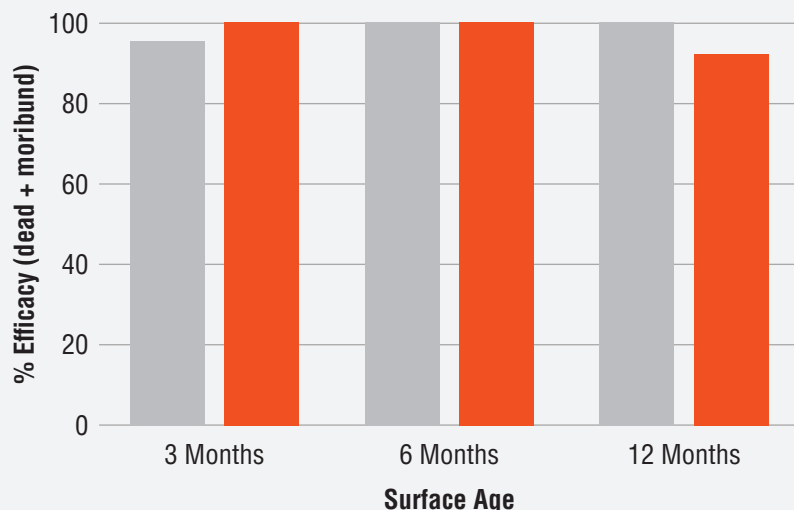

Residual Efficacy of CrossFire Against Pyrethroid-Resistant Bed Bugs



Method:

Target species: bed bug (*Cimex lectularius*), Winston-Salem pyrethroid-resistant strain (RR = 440 fold resistance to deltamethrin). CrossFire application: 1 gallon of finished dilution/1,000 ft². Four replications with 10 bed bugs per replication. Exposure duration: 5 minutes.

Mattress **Unpainted Wood**

What Does This Data Mean for Your Business?

Mattresses and unpainted wood are two of the more difficult real-world surfaces to treat. In addition to fast knockdown and kill, CrossFire provides long-lasting residual control on surfaces where bed bugs commonly find harborage. CrossFire can also be used in conjunction with heat treatments. Internal studies found no change in efficacy during a heat treatment (120°F for 2 hours).
