Sector Misting Concentrate may be used to aid in the prevention of New World Screwworm (*Cochliomyia hominivorax*) for Dairy and Beef Cattle, Sheep, Goats, Swine, and Horses.

Dilute 1 part concentrate in 400 parts water (0.32 fl. oz. per gallon) (2 teaspoonfuls per gallon) (0.025%).

For Dairy and Beef Cattle, Horses and Swine: Apply a quart per adult animal to wet the hair thoroughly with particular attention to the legs, flanks, barrel, topline and other body areas commonly attacked by those flies. Repeat daily as needed.

For Sheep and Goats: Thoroughly wet all portions of the body by dipping or spraying with sufficient pressure and with a nozzle adjustment to give penetration of the wool. Avoid contact with animal's eyes and mouth. Treat at a rate sufficient to wet the animal.
